



Dear S.H.A.R.E. Participants,

Your school has signed up for the S.H.A.R.E.S program offered by Save Mart, S-Mart, & Food Maxx stores. This program is a way for your school to earn money without you spending a penny more than what you normally spend on your groceries. Each time you shop at our supermarkets using the S.H.A.R.E.S Card, we will donate 3% of your purchase to your school.

- Enclosed you will find one or two S.H.A.R.E.S Card(s) per student, one for you and one for another family member or friend.
- These cards are not connected. Each card has it's own number therefore if you add value to one card you won't see it on the other card.
- These cards have no value at this time.
- You need to go to one of the stores mentioned above to add value to the card.

The card can be used two ways. Either you can add value (dollars) in advance and then use the balance every time you shop or you can add value after your groceries have been totaled. There is no dollar limit on the card, you can put the exact amount of your purchase each time you shop or add extra money for future shopping trips.

It is easy to use. To put value on your card:

- Go to any Save Mart, Food Maxx, or S-Mart Foods Store.
- Present your S.H.A.R.E.S Card to the cashier **before they ring your groceries.**
- Request that the cashier add value to your card. Cash, debit, all major credit cards, Golden State Advantage-Cash, and checks are accepted as payment (this can also be done after groceries are rung but **before payment has been made.**)
- Once the value has been added to your card, the cashier will return your card and a receipt with the balance on the bottom.
- Swipe your S.H.A.R.E.S Card to pay for your groceries.

Remember. 3% of the money you put on the S.H.A.R.E.S Card goes to your school, in your child's name.
